

ERASMUS at IES

All students interested in studying abroad are asked to carefully read the document **OGÓLNE ZASADY WSTĘPNEJ KWALIFIKACJI STUDENTÓW I DOKTORANTÓW ... rok akademicki 2019/2020** (available on IES website, Erasmus+) section. This document explains the University-wide rules for all students participating in the recruitment procedure.

First round of recruitment at IES closes on **FEBRUARY 26 2019** at 12 noon.

Who is eligible to take part in the recruitment procedure?

- 2nd and 3rd year BA students (3rd year if they plan to continue MA studies at IES UW and preferably for the Spring semester; carefully read item 13, page 2 of Ogólne zasady...).
- 1st-year MA students
- PHD students (but only to some locations)
- Min. GPA of 3.49
- Max. 1 „warunek” at time of recruitment
- We especially encourage students to study abroad during 3rd year of BA studies (winter semester), 1st year of MA studies (spring semester) and 2nd year of MA studies (winter semester).
- Extramural students, evening students and students who are not Polish citizens can apply (please read the document: Ogólne warunki...)

What to submit? When? Where?

- Submit your **APPLICATION** (template available on IES website, Erasmus section, document called **PODANIE o skierowanie na zagraniczne studia częściowe**), listing 1, 2 or 3 universities of your choice, ranked according to preference and stating whether you are interested in a full-year or 1-semester scholarship. This should be in **POLISH**.
- Submit **your certified GRADE AVERAGE for the LAST FULL YEAR of studies** you have completed [most likely for 2017/2018; if you completed your BA elsewhere, you need to obtain a certified grade point average from that institution]. Your GPA counts for 80% of your final score.
- **Motivation letter in English** explaining WHY you want to study in your chosen locations. 1 letter is sufficient. This counts for 20% of your final score.
- Submit paper version of documents at the IES Student Office by **Feb. 26 2019, noon (12 PM)**.
- Do not apply via USOS, but you will see results in USOS (in the following week).

SELECTION CRITERIA

- A committee consisting of:
- The Mobility Coordinator, Director of Students Affairs and a representative of the students government will rank the applications according to the following criteria:
- 80% applicant's grade point average
- 20% letter of motivation. To ace your letter of motivation show that you have done your research about the chosen University, the department and the courses offered. Prove that you have an interest in the host country's culture.
- The committee's report will be made public after the placements have been finalized.

- The list of universities with which IES UW has signed agreements and where you can study abroad follows on the next two pages of this document.
- All agreements are signed with English Studies Departments. All offer courses in English.
- Please note that if an agreement is signed for the entire year (two semesters), you can still apply for 1 semester only. Please list your preference in the APPLICATION you submit.
- If you are granted a semester-long scholarship, but wish to stay longer, you may apply for an extension [in October 2019].
