Access to the Library

A **student identification card** is necessary for registration in the library system.

Registration is possible via internet (http://www.buw.uw.edu.pl/) or in person at the Main University Library at Dobra 56/66 from Monday to Saturday, 9-20 at the Circulation Desk (the ground floor, on the left side from the entrance).

After registration a student card becomes a library card. The card is required when borrowing books or other resources from the Libraries.

Documentary resources

Loan services

Standard Ioan: students can borrow up to 5 volumes for 1 month and renew their loans twice, via authentication in the online catalogue. Owing to the fact that most books are stored off-site, books should be reserved in advance via the on-line catalogue.

Interlibrary loan: the books or journal articles not held by the University of Warsaw can be requested from other libraries by the interlibrary loan service via the circulation desk or by writing to the Library's e-mail:
